Jay was subsequently re-elected as Member for Cheltenham in 2006, 2010, 2014 and in 2018. Before becoming Premier, he held a range of portfolios including Environment and Conservation, Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation, Minister Assisting the Premier in Cabinet Business and Public Sector Management, Families and Communities, Housing, Ageing, Disability, Urban Development and Planning, Administrative Services, Local Government and Gambling. Jay and his wife Melissa have two young daughters, Lucinda and Alice.
